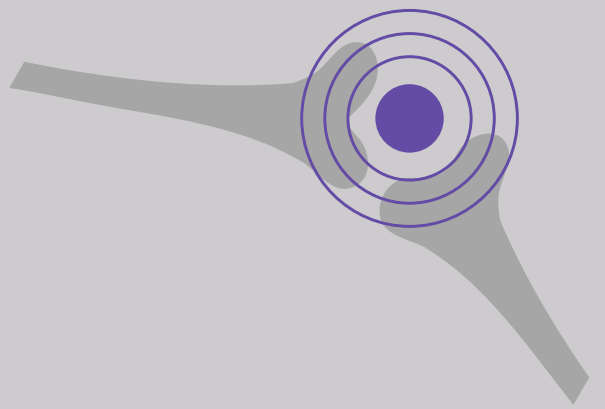

HOW COMMON IS IT IN THE UK?

Juvenile idiopathic arthritis (JIA) is the most common type of inflammatory arthritis in children and young people under 16.



The incidence rates (number of new cases per per 100,000 children and young people) is highest between the ages 0-4 and 9-14.
